



Dear Friends and Family,

I hope this letter finds you and your family doing well. I wanted to give you an update on what the Lord is doing in my life. Currently I am a junior at Pelham High School, and I am hoping to attend Auburn University once I graduate, where I would like to study elementary education. Over the past few years, the Lord has been working in my life in tremendous ways. Recently, He has provided me the opportunity to go on a short-term mission trip June 7-13 to Guatemala through Servant Life.

Servant Life is a non-profit mission organization that mobilizes students to proclaim Christ around the world. Last year, I heard about Servant Life and the opportunities they had to go on short-term mission trips overseas. As I was studying Matthew 28, a passage known as the Great Commission, I realized that God calls us to proclaim the gospel to people of all nations. After much prayer and guidance, I decided to commit to going on the trip next summer with my church.

In Guatemala, I will be working alongside the ministry partners of Servant Life. They serve children and families both in Guatemala City and in a more rural area called Pacaya. While we are there, our team will be sharing the love of Christ by hosting Bible clubs in the schools and the surrounding community. We have the opportunity to love on and care for these children and point them to the hope that can only be found in Christ. I am excited to see what the Lord does through our team, and also what He teaches me through this experience.

The Lord has called me to go, and I would love your support as I embark on this endeavor. First and foremost, I ask for your prayers. Specifically, join me in praying for the children we will be working with at the Clubhouse Guatemala at Camp Calvary. Another way that you can help is by giving financially to support my trip expenses. The trip will cost \$599 plus airfare. If you would like to make a contribution toward my trip, you can do so a few different ways:

- 1) Donations of \$50.00 or more will qualify as a tax-deductible gift. These checks must be made out to "Servant Life" [or directly to local church, depending on how your church is paying]. In order for your donation to be tax deductible, the check should *not* have my name on the memo line.
